

<u>Suggested clause to include in a will making a gift to a parish in the</u> <u>Catholic Archdiocese of Melbourne:</u>

"I give((a),(b),(c),(d) as listed below to be included) to the parish priest of the Parish (ABN and address to be included) of the Catholic Archdiocese of
Melbourne at the date of my death for the general purposes of the parish. In the event that the parish has changed its name or been amalgamated with another parish or parishes, this gift shall be given to the parish which at the date of my death incorporates the major area of the Parish as it exists at the time of making of this will. I direct that the receipt of the parish priest shall be a sufficient discharge to my trustee who shall not be obliged to see to the application of this gift."
(a) the sum of (nominate the amount you intend to give or other such provision as may be intended)
or
(b)percent of my total estate
or
(c) the residue of my estate
or
(d) nominate the specific asset, and if necessary any expressed wishes as to the intended use of the asset
